Travel Advisory - YELLOW FEVER ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR GUYANA AND JAMAICA

To Our Valued Passengers: The Government of Guyana has issued the following advisory to persons travelling to Guyana from specified countries, see listed below -

Entry into Guyana

It is advisable that persons traveling from countries listed as endemic, or at risk for yellow fever (mainly in Africa and Asia) should be in possession of a valid International Certificate of Vaccination or prophylaxis on arrival in Guyana.

The countries listed as endemic are mainly from the African and Asian continents and does not include, the United States of America, Canada, Europe and the Caribbean.

Exit Out of Guyana

Guyana, as part of South America is listed as one of the countries whose residents would require to be immunized and issued with a yellow fever certificate prior to travel.

To date, entry only to countries in South America, Africa and Asia will require a valid international certificate of vaccination (yellow card).
